The first technical session was graced with the presence of two eminent speakers: Prof. (Dr.) Mathew J. Manimala, Retired Professor, IIM, Bangalore and Ms. Sonia B. Aguliar, Assistant Professor, Fort Hays State University, USA. The session on ‘Emerging Employment Scenario in India and Challenges in Skill Education’ was chaired by Mrs. Smarty Mukundan, Assistant Professor, CUSAT-DDU KAUSHAL Kendra. The first session gave importance for skill education, which should be started from the very basic schooling. The main stream education and skilling should be synchronized.

The second technical session was mesmerizing with two speakers, Dr.

## INTERNATIONAL WORKSHOP

### 'High Impact Publications on Social Science Research'

Department of Psychology

The Department of Psychology in association with Berjaya University of Hospitality, Malaysia conducted an International Workshop on 'High Impact Publications on Social Science Research' on 3 February 2018. Dr. A Mavoothu, Director, School of Management, CUSAT, inaugurated the workshop. Every research should be aimed to be healthy, happy and a prosperous living for every layman, he said. The speaker of the workshop, Dr. Dileep Kumar M., is a Professor of Research Strategy, Behavioural Sciences, Consumer Behaviour, Hospitality, Tourism and Human Resource Management in Berjaya University College, Malaysia. The first session discussed about 'why a research paper is easily get rejected by the journals'. He described about the general and scientific causes behind these rejections. The next session described about 'how a research paper should be written'. Within this he stressed two important topics and they are 'Research gap' and 'Implications'. A research gap is the missing element in a previously conducted research and implications simply means the application of research findings. He pointed out that a person doing research should identify 2 important part of a research they are (1) Time period of the study and (2) The research gap . There were also discussions about various aspects based on the topic.

The Department of Psychology conducted two day National Seminar on the topic 'Neurodevelopmental Disability' which was given the name UDAAN on 19 & 20 December 2017. The central theme of the seminar was 'Early Identification and Intervention of Neurodevelopmental Disability'. The National Seminar was officially inaugurated by Mr. Anish Mohan, National Coordinator at The Institute for Person Centered Approaches in India. Mr. Anish Mohan is a motivational speaker and a person who challenged his own disability. He can be considered as an example of the strength of the human mind by overcoming his disability and inspires others to do the same. The main focus of the speech was to 'See the Ability rather than the Disability'. He concluded by voicing a thought "If you want to Win, you have to endure Pain".

The first session led by Dr. P.S. Sukumaran, Dean and Director of School of Behavioral Sciences, MG University. The session highlighted about Neurodevelopmental Disabilities, various disabilities under 'Rights of Persons with Disability Act-2016' and the causes of neurodevelopmental disabilities. ## Literacy of Migrant Labours

The Kerala State Literacy Mission Authority (KSLMA) has commenced training for instructors who have been entrusted with the task of teaching Malayalam and Hindi to migrant workers at Perumbavoor from 01 August 2017 under its pilot literacy programme for migrant workers. The training was held at our college and 34 instructors from the college participated in the programme. Perumbavoor Municipality chairperson Sathi Jayakrishnan inaugurated the training programme while K.K. Krishnakumar of the KSLMA led the training classes. The pilot programme aims to make migrant workers in the perumbavoor municipality, the main hub of migrant workers in Kerala, fluent in Malayalam and Hindi in four months. As per the plan of KSLMA, one study centre each will be assigned to the literacy programme in the 27 wards in the municipality. The timings of the classes have been fixed in a flexible manner-after 6 pm and during week ends-to ensure the migrant workers, maximum participation without affecting their means of livelihood. There will be at least five hours of classes weekly under the programme, Five-ten study centres of 15-20 participants will be organized under KSLMA's Continuing Education Centres (CEC). The study centres, libraries, schools, other institutions, work centres and migrant's shelters etc. will be chosen for the literacy programme.

The digital book was released by education minister C. Raveendranath who handed over the CD to literacy mission director P.S. Sreekala. The digital book to be used at 'Changathi' (the particular project under the literacy mission) study centres and at junctions where migrant workers usually gather, by making maximum use of available electronic systems, will further popularize the project, said an official release from the Mission.

The digital book was prepared by animation and graphic design students of our college who were also the instructors of the model 'Changathi' project launched at Perumbavoor earlier, with the support of teachers. The digital book comprises 10 lessons through which Malayalam is taught with the help of Malayalam and Hindi alphabets and words besides pictures.

The lessons are prepared based on the situations migrant workers might confront at their workplace and residential places. "Instead of going directly into alphabets and words, the students are made to learn Malayalam easily through life situations. The lessons are based on various sectors they interact continuously including food, health, travel and equipment." The release said.

As many as 5,268 migrant workers in the state are now learning Malayalam under the project, which had begun at Perumbavoor with 432 students.
